

## Understanding Risks&Threats

- 1. National e.g.
  - 1. state actors, resilience, regulatory
  - 2. interoperate
- 2. Digital e.g.
  - 1. inclusivity, comprehensible (to whom)
  - 2. biometrics not a panacea at all
- 3. Systems e.g.
  - 1. analog, failure modes
  - 2. work on paper, disconnected
