## 1. Revision of Your Paper and Camera-Ready Submission

It is mandatory that you revise your paper according to the referees' comments. Please upload your camera-ready on the web site <http://cnd1.iit.cnr.it/wiopt04/authors/> (used for paper submission) using the login and password you received for the submission.

**The PDF file camera-ready version of your paper must be uploaded as a NO LATER THAN Sunday FEBRUARY 15, 2004.**

The PDF file MUST contain all the fonts, images and tables as required.

### 1.1 Formatting Instructions

Your paper must be formatted for A4 size (297x210mm) paper, single-column format.

Top Margin: 1 inch

Left and Right Margins: 1 inch

Bottom Margin: 1.2 inch

Paragraphs left and right justified. First line of text after headings not indented, other paragraphs indent 0.2"

For the main text, please use Times New Roman fonts 10-point type and single-line spacing.

## 2. Headings

Headings should be bold capitalized. First level Headings: 12 point font. There should be a 20-point space before, and 10-point space after, a first level headings.

Second level Headings: 10 point font. There should be a 12-point space before, and 6-point space after a first level headings.

Third level Headings are not numbered: 10 point font. There should be a 10-point space before, no space after, e.g.,

**Level3 Heading.** Headings should be capitalized (i.e., nouns, verbs, and all other words except articles, prepositions, and conjunctions should be set with an initial capital) and should, with the exception of the title, be aligned to

### 2.1 Page Limits

Due to the total page limit for the proceedings,

- if accepted as a regular paper, your camera-ready paper should not exceed 10 pages
- if accepted for a poster presentation, the camera-ready of your extended abstract should not exceed 2 pages

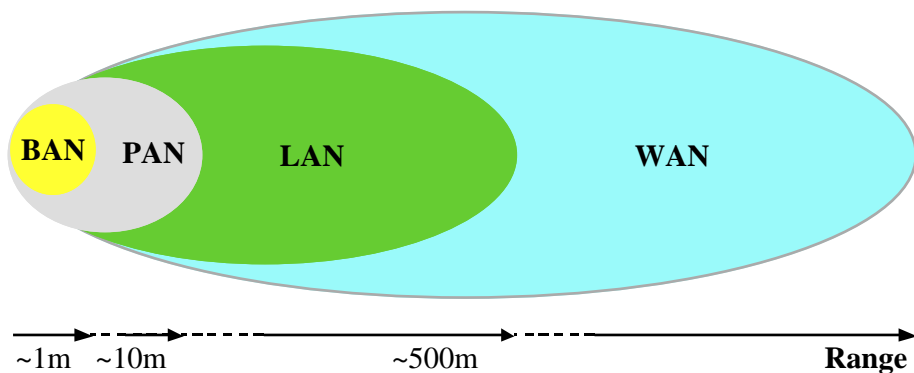
**The excess pages will not appear in the proceedings!**

Captions for figures should be after figure, for table should be before table. Captions in 9 point type
