Demonstrated Sessions = (Mostly) silent channel

- Please stay muted unless you are in a one-on-one session with a demonstrator.
- Nothing exciting will be going on in the sessions: the channel will be generally silent, but we will stand by to help.
- You can generally do two actions:
 - ask a questions or ask for help via the chat function.
 - The lecturer or a demonstrator will pick up your question and address it globally, or initiate a one-on-one help session with you
 - ask to be ticked via the MLRD ticking sign-up form
 - You will be taken by a demonstrator to a breakout room as soon as possible
 - Turn on camera and mic
 - Expect to be asked to screen-share and explain your code.

Procedure for Ticking

- Make sure your code passes the pretester before you request a tick.
- To request a tick, pleasef fill in the form.
- You can announce your intention to be ticked for more than one tick, but demonstrators will always give preference to older ticks.
- Try to stay on top of your ticks throughout the term.

Missing Pretester Deadlines

- If you have missed a pretester deadline, you have to ask your DoS to send an email to sht25@cl.cam.ac.uk to unlock the pretester again.
- Unlocking the pretester will not be immediate and could even take up to 2 weeks. Avoid getting yourself into this position.
- If you pass the pretester before the deadline but don't manage to get a one-on-one ticking session before the deadline, you can still get the tick without asking your DoS.
- It's only the pretester that closes down.
- 15/3 is the last in-term deadline for the last 3 ticks.
- If you still have outstanding ticks after the session on 15/3, you will have to come to the last-chance session on Friday 30/4 at the start of Easter term to get all remaining ticks.
