Programming in C and C++

A grand debate is being planned by a society that has among its members a large number of computer professionals and working programmers. The motion to be put is “That the languages C and C++ should be consigned to outer darkness and their use banned in all serious computer projects”. Prepare as your answer to this question a briefing document that could explain to people intending to attend the debate what the major points both for and against C and C++ will be, and the lines of arguments that are liable to be used to show how important they are.
